HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN BOX CITY:

- 1. Make a reservation: A limited number of free tickets to guarantee entry are available at 9 AM, 10 AM, 11 AM, 12 PM and 1 PM. One child per ticket, maximum 4 tickets per reservation. Adult companions do not need a ticket-only participating children do. Arrive at least 5 minutes before your reservation time.
